PURPOSE FOR PROJECT LIAISON



A WHOLE-OF-DEPARTMENT APPROACH

To provide a single point of contact for large projects to ensure that we have a whole of department approach to protecting public health and the environment while growing as a state.

INTER-AGENCY TEAMWORK

Point of Contact between Economic Development partners (EDPNC and Dept. of Commerce) for large projects and initiatives.

INTRA-AGENCY COLLABORATION

Maintain strong communication between DEQ Divisions and coordinate opportunities to maximize collaboration and increase efficiency.

PERMIT COORDINATION

Make stakeholders aware of permitting needs and minimize "surprises" for all parties. Ensure that permit reviewers have the information necessary to complete a thorough, science-based evaluation.


