## **SUMMARY**

## NEUSE RIVER BASIN HYDROLOGIC MODEL PROJECT LAUNCH MEETING

February 25, 2008 512 N. Salisbury Street Archdale Building – Ground Floor Hearing Room Raleigh, North Carolina

- 1. Tom Fransen opened the meeting at 10:05 AM and John Morris provided opening remarks.
- 2. Brian McCrodden and Steve Nebiker presented the project scope and schedule.
- 3. Sydney Miller led a discussion of the project budget and cost sharing structure.
  - The total project budget is \$350,000.
  - The NC Division of Water Resources will fund 75% of the project, which is \$262,500.
  - The remaining cost to be shared among the Potential Partners (the larger water users in the Neuse River Basin) is \$87,500.
  - Potential Partners include: City of Creedmoor, City of Durham, City of Goldsboro, Town
    of Hillsborough, Johnston County, Neuse Regional WASA, Orange-Alamance WA,
    Progress Energy Carolinas, City of Raleigh, South Granville WASA, Town of
    Smithfield, City of Wilson, and Weyerhaeuser Company.
  - Stakeholders agreed that costs for each of the Potential Partners would be based on relative water use for calendar year 2007.
  - Each Potential Partner will provide its annual average day raw water withdrawal for calendar year 2007 to Sydney Miller. The Neuse Regional WASA will provide an estimate of its anticipated average day water withdrawal for its first year of operation.
  - Sydney Miller will send a revised project cost share table to all Potential Partners by February 29, 2008, provided Potential Partners send their water use data in a timely manner.
  - Stakeholders agreed that the NC Division of Water Resources would simply send invoices to the Potential Partners in July 2008 for each Potential Partner's cost share amount.
- 4. Tom Fransen presented the project's organization.
  - Neelufa Sarwar will serve as the Division of Water Resources' leader for the project.
  - Stakeholders are invited to appoint representatives to serve on the project's Technical Review Committee (TRC). The TRC will provide guidance to the consultants in developing the model.
  - The next meeting of the full stakeholder group will not occur for another 8-12 months.
