I would like to thank you and your staff for the assistance you have provided in managing the Dan River incident. I have been in communication with several members of your office and it is obvious that both the United States Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) and the North Carolina Department of Environment and Natural Resources (DENR) understand the gravity of this matter as well as the difficult and complicated path forward in finding appropriate short-and long-term solutions.

These discussions helped both DENR and the EPA review the enforcement and remediation tools and expertise that each of our agencies possess, and share our respective experiences and regulatory authorities, particularly in light of the interstate nature of the spill. I am writing to invite the EPA to partner with DENR in the responsible resolution of not only the Dan River matter, but other environmental issues at the thirteen additional Duke Energy sites in North Carolina. Your team is already familiar with the steps DENR is taking to address this matter, and has expressed support of our approach. Participation by Region 4 personnel will bring additional knowledge, expertise, and experience to a difficult and long-standing problem.

Thank you for your consideration and I hardly need to suggest that time is of the essence in moving forward together.
