## Purpose – NC G.S. 113A-129.1-3

#### Codified at 15A NCAC 07O. 0101\*

- **Preserve** representative coastal N.C. ecosystems
- Conduct relevant research to inform sound management of coastal resources
- Increase awareness and understanding of coastal ecosystems, their importance, and the effects humans have on them
- Accommodate compatible traditional uses\*\*
  - \*Paraphrased
  - \*\*Traditional uses = public trust uses including fishing, hunting, navigation, and recreation

# **Background**

- NC National Estuarine Research Reserve (NC NERR) designated in 1985, 1991 (Coastal Zone Management Act)
- NC Coastal Reserve created in 1989 per amendment to NC Coastal Area Management Act (CAMA)
- The NC NERR is part of the NC Coastal Reserve (CAMA, NC Administrative Code)
- Reserves are also State Nature Preserves (CAMA, State Nature Preserves Act)


## **Organizational Structure**





## National Estuarine Research Reserve System






# **Reserve Specifics**

- 10 sites protecting 44,000 acres
- 4 program areas (Stewardship, Education, Training, Research)
- Programmatic themes: water quality, coastal and estuarine ecosystem protection, coastal hazards resilience
- 16 staff in 4 offices (Manteo, Columbia, Beaufort, Wilmington)
- Funding Sources
  - Federal 315 for operation of the NC NERR
  - Federal 306 for support of state sites
  - State Appropriations
  - External Funding



### 2024 By the Numbers
















# **Impact Beyond the Numbers**

- Serve as protective barriers buffering communities from storms
- Serve as integral parts of local communities, supporting human health and well-being and providing ecological benefits
- Support local economies as people visit the sites and spend time and dollars in local communities
- Grow the next generation of coastal stewards and professionals
- Meet information needs through stakeholder and end-user engagement
- Inform policy through research and demonstration projects such as living shoreline design and oyster management

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19 authorized commercial businesses and institutions brought 40,798 visitors to 4 Reserve sites for compatible recreational and educational activities in 2024, equating to

\$1,428,198 in estimated minimum profit for these authorized users

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## **Rules Review Process**

- Legislative Periodic Review and Expiration of Existing Rules process (G.S. 150B-21.3A) requires review of rules every 10 years
- The rules review process requires that all rule citations are classified as necessary or unnecessary:
  - <u>Necessary</u>: any rule other than an unnecessary rule <u>Unnecessary</u>: a rule that the agency determines to be obsolete, redundant, or otherwise not needed
- Necessary rules must be readopted

## **15A NCAC 070**

- Department of Environmental Quality rules
- Scheduled for review by Rules Review Commission in April 2026
- Periodic review in 2017 with Local Advisory Committee and CRC input; rules were readopted and amended effective February 2022
- 8 rule citations
