Marine Corps Installations East-Marine Corps Base Camp Lejeune (MCIEAST-MCB CAMLEJ) is proposing to continue its current range and training operations. Additionally, MCIEAST-MCB CAMLEJ proposes to incorporate new and emerging range and training operations, systems, and real property improvements to sustain and enhance military training on MCIEAST-MCB CAMLEJ and support the command's proposed implementation of installation and logistics support requirements for supporting Force Design 2030 initiatives. Pursuant to 15 Code of Federal Regulations section 930.33(a)(3)(i), the command reviewed the proposed actions and found that the limited activities within the coastal zone would be de minimis. Accordingly, this letter forwards enclosure (1) and requests the North Carolina Division of Coastal Management's concurrence that the activities should not be subject to State agency review.
