Community	Project Name	Project Description	Funding Amount
Burgaw	East Wilmington Street Rain Garden	The Town of Burgaw will construct a rain garden on townowned floodplain property to capture and filter stormwater. The project will reduce flooding along E. Wilmington Street, improve water quality, and serve as an educational feature showcasing green stormwater infrastructure.	\$181,687.00
Nags Head	Harvey Sound Access Living Shoreline	The Town of Nags Head will restore 500 feet of shoreline at Harvey Sound using stone sills and wave attenuator units. The project will enhance 0.75 acres of marsh with native plants, improving habitat, reducing erosion, and supporting water quality improvements in Roanoke Sound.	\$459,362.00
Vandemere	Vandemere Waterfront Park Living Shoreline	The Town of Vandemere will repair existing riprap and install additional living shoreline stabilization along its waterfront park. These improvements will reduce erosion, dissipate wave action, and protect public park assets. Construction-level design plans have already been developed to support implementation.	\$565,000.00
