

Use of Total Residual Chlorine Sealed Standards in a Field Setting (NC WW/GW LC Policy 12/22/2007)

Laboratories currently certified by the North Carolina Wastewater/Groundwater Laboratory Certification program as Commercial, Municipal, Industrial, or Other may use sealed standards (liquid or "Gel-type") for daily standard curve verification in a field setting. For this application, a *field setting* is defined as:

A location off the primary facility grounds and/or at such a distance that sample collection and analysis could not be achieved at the primary facility within the parameter holding time (i.e., 15 minutes).
