**SUMMARY OF NOTICE OF INTENT TO REMEDIATE A DRY-CLEANING
SOLVENT FACILITY OR ABANDONED SITE**

Pursuant to N.C.G.S. §143-215.104L, on behalf of the Town of Nashville, the North Carolina Department of Environmental Quality's (NCDEQ's) private contractor has prepared a Notice of Intent to Remediate a Dry-Cleaning Solvent Facility or Abandoned Site (NOI). The purpose of this Summary of the NOI is to notify the community of the proposed remedy for the contamination site and invite comment on the proposed remedy.

ACME Cleaners formerly conducted dry-cleaning operations at the at 200 South Boddie Street property, in Nashville, North Carolina. The property is currently occupied by the Nashville Parks and Recreation Department. Dry-cleaning solvent contamination in soil and/or groundwater has been identified at the following parcel(s):

200 South Boddie Street in Nashville; Parcel No. 380119501717
227 West Church Street, in Nashville; Parcel No. 380118409753

An investigation of the extent of contamination has been completed. A risk assessment of the contaminated properties concluded that the contamination poses no unacceptable risks. A Risk Management Plan (RMP) has been prepared which proposes using land-use controls to prevent current and future risks at the affected properties.

The elements of the complete NOI are included in the RMP which is available online at deq.nc.gov/ncdsca under "DSCA Public Notices and Announcements".

The public comment period begins May 21, 2026, and ends June 20, 2026.

Comments must be in writing and submitted to NCDEQ no later than June 20, 2026. Written requests for a public meeting may be submitted to NCDEQ no later than June 20, 2026.
