A Draft Renewal Permit has been prepared for ECOFLO, Inc. to store and treat hazardous waste at the facility under the Federal Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA). North Carolina has been authorized by the United States Environmental Protection Agency to administer RCRA including the Hazardous and Solid Waste Amendments (HSWA) of 1984. ECOFLO, Inc., founded in 1982, has been operating at this site under a permit granted by the State of North Carolina and the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency since 1985. The State has determined that ECOFLO's proposed activities as identified in the application satisfy the full intent of the North Carolina Hazardous Waste Management Rules and Solid Waste Management Act as amended. When finalized this draft permit issued by the State of North Carolina will constitute a complete permit under the Federal Resource Conservation and Recovery Act.

ECOFLO, Inc. is a commercial hazardous waste storage and treatment facility which accepts containerized and bulk shipments of hazardous wastes for on-site management in containers and tanks. Wastes are received for on-site storage in their original containers prior to off-site treatment and disposal. Wastes are also received for on-site treatment and consolidation prior to shipment to another facility for treatment and disposal. The permit will allow ECOFLO to manage up to 95,645 gallons of hazardous waste in eight container storage areas, up to 40 cubic yards of hazardous waste in the roll-off container storage area, and up to 70,000 gallons of hazardous waste in seven tanks. These wastes include, but are not limited to, organics (including halogenated and non-halogenated solvents), oils, phenols, paints, pigments, cyanides, corrosives, heavy metal bearing wastes, metal sludges, lab packs and non-hazardous wastes. Hazardous waste management activities include: storage of hazardous waste in containers and tanks; consolidation of hazardous wastes for transportation; bulking of hazardous waste for transportation; fuels blending; materials blending; filtering; physical treatment; neutralization; brokering of wastes to third party treatment storage and disposal facilities; and de packing and repackaging of laboratory chemicals.

The North Carolina Hazardous Waste Management Rules require that the public be given a forty-five (45) day period to comment on the draft permit. This forty-five (45) day period will commence on July 22, 2026, and end on September 5, 2026.
