Division of Marine Fisheries

9,600 interviews with recreational anglers to obtain catch and effort data

1,139 homes weatherized

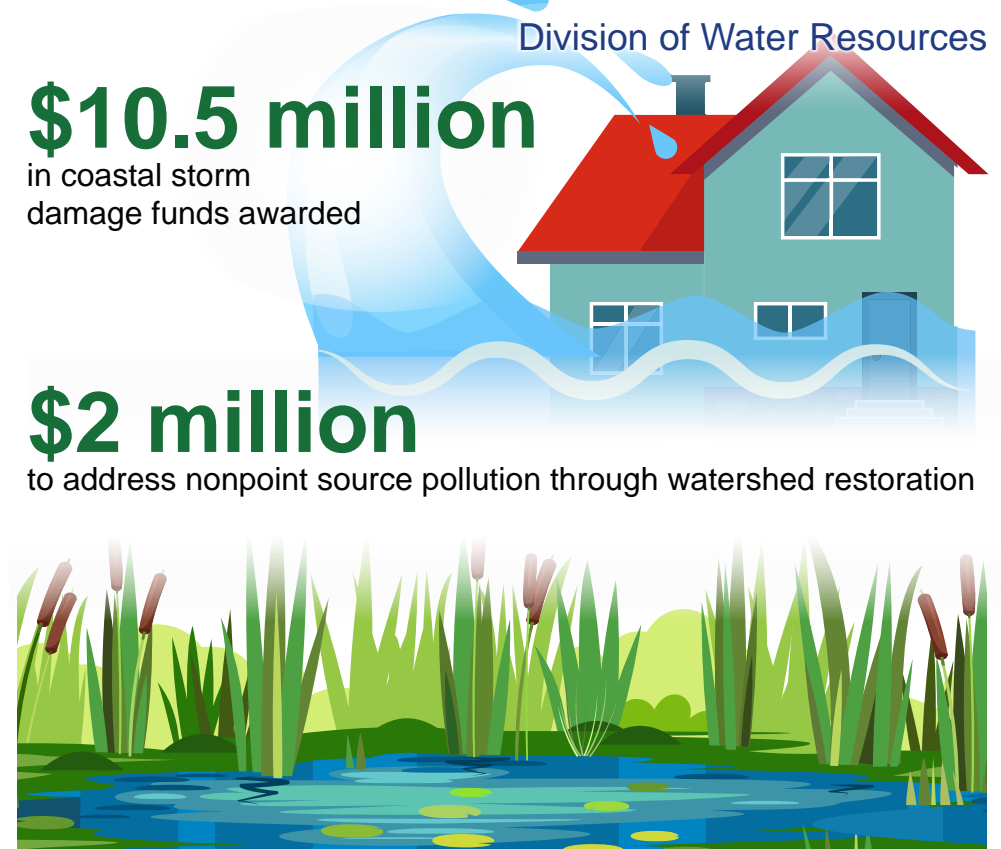
