State General Permit Renewal Animal Feeding Operations



- Three General Permits
 - Swine
 - Cattle/Dairy
 - Poultry with Liquid Waste Management System
- New/Expanding Swine Operations are NOT eligible
- 5-year permit cycle
 - Current permit expires Sept 30, 2019



State General Permit Renewal Timeline – Permit Development

- May 3, 2018 Settlement Agreement
- Stakeholder Process:
 - Nov 13, 2018 Posted draft permit
 - Nov 27, 2018 Stakeholder meetings technical workgroups and public meeting
 - Utilized professional 3rd party facilitator
 - Dec 21, 2018 deadline for written comments
- Public Comment Period Jan 30 March 4, 2019
 - Feb 19, 2019 Kenansville Hearing
 - Feb 26, 2019 Statesville Hearing
- April 12, 2019 Permits finalized/signed



State General Permit Renewal Key Changes

- Statutory/Regulatory References added to every permit condition
- I.4 Amendments to be submitted to DWR transparency
- I.9 PLAT required if soil test P-index of 400 or higher
- II.20 Reduce Drift Potential may require alternate application equipment or new BMPs
- II.24 Rainbreakers required
- II.28 Haybale removal within 24 months
- III.2.b Waste level markers survey/certify every 5 years
- III.12 Groundwater Monitoring for lagoons in 100-year floodplain
- III.15 Records Retention 5 years
- III.18 New Annual Report
