
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

Gantt, P.E., Regional Engineer, Land Quality Section, make the following:

#### I. FINDINGS OF FACT

- The subject property is located off of North Washington Street in Reidsville, Rockingham County, North Carolina. The project is known as the Reidsville Senior Center.
  - B. The owner of record is the City of Reidsville, A Municipal Corporation.
- On September 17, 2014, Thomas Wiggins as Assistant City Manager signed a Financial Responsibility/Ownership form, stating, under oath, that the City of Reidsville, a Municipal Corporation was financially responsible for the land disturbance.
- An erosion control plan (hereinafter "Plan") for the project was received on September 19, 2014 D. and was approved on October 17, 2014.
- On April 21, 2016, a duly authorized representative of the Land Quality Section (hereinafter E. "LQS"), North Carolina Department of Environmental Quality (hereinafter "DEQ"), inspected the subject property and determined that a land-disturbing activity had occurred on the site in violation of the Sedimentation Pollution Control Act (hereinafter "SPCA") of 1973 (G.S. 113A-50, et seq.).
- The land-disturbing activity was conducted for institutional purposes and covered approximately F. 3.7 acres.
- On April 28, 2016, the LQS Regional Engineer sent a Notice of Violation (hereinafter "Notice") to the City of Reidsville, a Municipal Corporation, by certified mail, return receipt requested, which was received on May 2, 2016, and which cited violations of the SPCA. A copy of the Notice is attached hereto and

incorporated herein by reference. The Notice required that the corrective measures stated therein be completed within 10 days of receipt of the Notice.

#### II. CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- A. An initial civil penalty may be assessed against the City of Reidsville, a Municipal Corporation, pursuant to North Carolina General Statute 113A-64(a) for the violations committed on the subject property.
- B. On April 21, 2016, violations of one or more of the requirements of the SPCA or the rules adopted thereunder existed on the subject property as follows:
  - 1. N.C.G.S. 113A-57(5) was violated for failure to conduct a land-disturbing activity in accordance with the approved erosion and sedimentation control plan.
  - 2. N.C.G.S. 113A-57(3) was violated for failure, when land-disturbing activity that will disturb more than one acre is undertaken on a tract, to plant or otherwise provide a permanent ground cover sufficient to restrain erosion after completion of construction or development within 15 working days or 90 calendar days following completion of construction or development, whichever period is shorter, as required by 15A NCAC 04B .0107(b), except as provided in 15A NCAC 04B .0124(e).
  - 3. 15A NCAC 04B .0105 was violated for failure to take all reasonable measures to protect all public and private property from damage caused by land-disturbing activity.
  - 4. 15A NCAC 04B .0113 was violated for failure to install and maintain all temporary and permanent erosion and sedimentation control measures as required by the approved plan or any provision of the SPCA or rules adopted thereunder.

#### III. DECISIONS

- A. Pursuant to N.C.G.S. 113A-64(a) and 15A NCAC 04C .0103, and the authority delegated to me by the Director, Division of Land Resources, I, Matthew E. Gantt, P.E, Regional Engineer, Land Quality Section, do hereby assess a civil penalty against the City of Reidsville, a Municipal Corporation, in the amount of \$4,400 for the initial violations as cited in the Notice.
- B. In determining the amount of this penalty, I have considered the criteria in 15A NCAC 04C .0106 and N.C.G.S. 113A-64(a)(3).
- C. I hereby put the City of Reidsville, a Municipal Corporation, on notice that I reserve the right to initiate further enforcement action for any violations occurring after April 21, 2016.



On April 21, 2016, personnel of this office inspected a project located on N. Washington Street, Reidsville in Rockingham County, North Carolina. This inspection was performed to determine compliance with the North Carolina Sedimentation Pollution Control Act (SPCA) of 1973 and General Permit - NCG 010000 to Discharge Stormwater Under The National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System for Construction Activities (Construction Stormwater Permit NCG 010000). The inspection revealed a land-disturbing activity of approximately 3.7 acres being conducted.

It is our understanding that you and/or your firm are responsible for this land-disturbing activity. The purpose of this letter is to inform you that this activity was found to be in violation of the SPCA, G.S. 113A-50 to 66, Title 15A, North Carolina Administrative Code (NCAC), Chapter 4 and Construction Stormwater Permit NCG 010000. If you feel that you are not responsible for the following violations, please notify this office immediately.

#### The violations of the SPCA that were found are:

- 1. Failure to conduct a land-disturbing activity in accordance with the approved erosion and sedimentation control plan. G.S. 113A-57(5). Failure to follow the approved plan and failure to maintain erosion control measures constitutes this violation.
- 2. Failure when a land-disturbing activity that will disturb more than one acre is undertaken on a tract, to provide a permanent ground cover sufficient to restrain erosion on such exposed areas within 15 working days or 90 calendar days, whichever is shorter, after completion of construction or development. G.S. 113A-57(3) and 15A NCAC 4B .0107(b).
- 3. Failure to take all reasonable measures to protect all public and private property from damage by such land-disturbing activities. 15A NCAC 4B .0105. Failure to follow the approved plan and failure to maintain erosion control measures constitutes this violation.
- 4. Failure to install and maintain all temporary and permanent erosion and sedimentation control measures as required by the approved plan or any provision of the SPCA, and rules adopted thereunder, during or after the development of a site. 15 NCAC 4B .0113. Failure to maintain erosion control measures constitutes this violation.

## The violations of the Construction Stormwater Permit NCG 010000 that were found are:

- 1. Failure to implement the erosion and sedimentation control plan. The Permittee must implement and follow the erosion and sedimentation control plan. The approved erosion and sedimentation control plan is considered a condition of Construction Stormwater Permit NCG 010000. NCG 010000 Section III. 3) (a).
- 2. Failure to provide ground stabilization, NCG 010000 Section II. B. 2).
- a. Soil stabilization shall be achieved on any area of a site where land-disturbing activities have temporarily or permanently ceased according to the following schedule:
  - i. All perimeter dikes, swales, ditches, perimeter slopes and all slopes steeper than 3 horizontal to 1 vertical (3: 1) shall be provided temporary or permanent stabilization with ground cover as soon as practicable but in any event within 7 calendar days from

the last land-disturbing activity.

- ii. All other disturbed areas shall be provided temporary or permanent stabilization with ground cover as soon as practicable but in any event within 14 calendar days from the last land-disturbing activity.
- b. Conditions In meeting the stabilization requirements above, the following conditions or exemptions shall apply:
  - i. All slopes 50' in length or greater shall apply the ground cover within 7 days except when the slope is flatter than 4: 1. Slopes less than 50' shall apply ground cover within 14 days except when slopes are steeper than 3: 1, the 7 day-requirement applies.
- 3. Failure to meet self-inspection and reporting requirements. NCG 010000 Section II. B. 3).
  - a. A rain gauge shall be maintained in good working order on the site
  - b. A written record of the daily rainfall amounts shall be retained and all records shall be made available upon request.
  - c. Erosion and sedimentation control measures shall be inspected to ensure that they are operating correctly. Inspection records must be maintained for each inspection event and for each measure. At a minimum, inspection of measures must occur at the frequency indicated below:
    - i. All erosion and sedimentation control measures must be inspected by or under the direction of the permittee at least once every seven calendar days,
    - ii. All erosion and sediment control measures must be inspected by or under the direction of the permittee within 24 hours after any storm event of greater than 0.50 inches of rain per 24 hour period.
  - d. Once land disturbance has begun on the site, stormwater runoff discharge outfalls shall be inspected by observation for erosion, sedimentation and other stormwater discharge characteristics such as clarity, floating solids, and oil sheens. Inspections of the outfalls shall be made at least once every seven calendar days and within 24 hours after any storm event of greater than 0.50 inches of rain per 24 hour period.
- 4. Failure to install and maintain BMPs and control measures, NCG 010000 Section III. 4)
  The permittee must select, install, implement and maintain best management practices
  (BMPs) and control measures that minimize pollutants in the discharge to meet the requirements of this permit.

5. Failure to operate and maintain control measures, NCG 010000 Section IV, 1)

The permittee shall at all times properly operate and maintain all control measures and systems of treatment and control (and related appurtenances) which are installed or used by the permittee to achieve compliance with the conditions of this general permit.

#### To correct these violations, you must:

- 1. Repair and stabilize eroded areas, including slopes, throughout entire site.
- 2. Remove accumulated sediment from skimmer flexible pipe in Basin #2 (so skimmer can function properly).
- 3. Repair and maintain silt fence where damaged throughout entire site.
- 4. Provide a stabilized surface for storage and staging of building materials. Note: this item has been noted in the following inspection reports: 5/27/15, 7/22/15, 10/28/15, 11/12/15, and 11/25/15. The item has not been completed to date.
- 5. Remove accumulated sediment from Skimmer Basin #1. In addition, install diversion berms along top of slope and slope drains to convey surface water into basin (similar to what has been done around SB #2).
- 6. Install a rain gauge onsite. In addition, adequately complete NPDES Records and ensure the records are maintained and available at all times.
- 7. Seed and mulch remaining bare/disturbed/sparse areas located outside the active construction areas.
- 8. Adequately control dust from the construction site.
- 9. Submit NPDES rainfall records for December 1, 2015 thru April 21, 2016 to this office for review.

#### **SPCA Violations**

On May 2, 2016, you received a Notice of Violations indicating that you and/or your firm were conducting a land-disturbing activity located on N. Washington Street, Reidsville in Rockingham County, North Carolina that was in violation of the Sedimentation Pollution Control Act of 1973.

The compliance deadline outlined in the Notice was May 12, 2016. A compliance inspection of this project on June 15, 2016, indicated that the violations outlined in the Notice had not been corrected.

Because the violations were not corrected on or before the deadline for compliance, which was May 12, 2016, this matter is being referred to the Director, Division of Land Resources, for enforcement. I urge you to correct these violations immediately. A civil penalty of up to \$5000.00 per day for violations is authorized by G.S. 113A-64. A penalty may be assessed from the date of the violation until the date the violations are corrected. Based on inspection conducted today, the following items have been completed in NOV since last inspection: Item #1, Item #2, Item #4, the remaining portion of Item #5 is not needed now (concerning removing accumulated sediment) since parking lot has been stoned, part of Item #6 has been completed (need to fill out reports properly), Item #7, Item #8, and Item #9. In addition, a response to the Construction Stormwater Permit Violations has not been received to date. This response was required within 10 calendar days from receipt of NOV. Note: the NPDES Reports for Item #6 were not reviewed due to escalating tensions between Contractor and I during the inspection. Contractor indicated he was not going to complete the remaining items and/or complete anything not shown on the plans, referring to the additional silt fence needing to be installed on NE side of site. Contractor also alluded to removing all the silt fence and not re-installing. The silt fence is the only remaining measure once the diversion berms and basins are removed. Therefore, the silt fence will still be required. Failure to comply could lead to additional fines of up to \$5,000 per day being issued.
  - 3. Work on building continues. Outside of building is nearing completion in some areas. Work on canopy in front of building still under construction. Curb & Gutter has been installed and stone has been placed on all areas, except for small area close to the building where crews are still working. Crews were cutting vegetation off exterior chain link fence & appear to be removing fence.
  - 4. The silt fence around perimeter of site must be repaired & maintained and extended as noted in the inspection report. In addition, adequate inlet protection for all curb/yard/drop inlets must be re-installed and/or repaired. Once these items have been completed, Basins #1 & #2 may be removed from service to allow final installation of SS line and fill placement around building.
