PRELIMINARY MATTERS

Chair Susan White called the meeting to order at 10:00 am.

Chair White read Executive Order No. 1 regarding avoidance of conflict of interest. She asked if anyone has a known conflict of interest or potential conflicts. Mr. Steve Wilson recused himself from action items involving the Town of Mooresville.

Ms. Emily Sutton read the Evaluation of the Statement of Economic Interests filed by Dr. Joshua Heitman. Dr. Heitman was sworn in as a member.

Those in attendance introduced themselves.

Chair White asked for a motion to approve the minutes of the August 21, 2025, meeting. Mr. Ben Brown moved to approve the minutes with the modification to correct the spelling of Ms. Masemore's name on the attendee's list. Ms. Robin Smith made a second. The motion passed.

Chair White removed the "*Town of Mooresville Ordinance Review & Delegation Request*" action item from the agenda based on advice from Counsel regarding changes to the proposed ordinance needing to be incorporated.

ACTION ITEMS

Town of Knightdale Review:

Mr. Parrish presented the findings from review of this program. Staff recommended to continue the program's delegation with review for 3 quarters with a follow up report to presented during

the 2026 Q3 meeting. A discussion ensued. Ms. Smith made a motion to approve the recommendation made by DEMLR staff with the request for an interim report be provided as an information item regarding the Town's plan to address the noted deficiencies. Mr. Brian North made a second. The motion passed.

City of Monroe Ordinance Review:

Mr. Parrish presented the City's ordinance and adopted changes for formal review by the Commission. Mr. Parrish reminded members that an informal review had been conducted during the August 2025 SCC meeting. Mr. Brown made a motion to approve the ordinance updates. Mr. Michael Taylor made a second. The motion passed.

NCDOT Annual Program Review:

Mr. Parrish reported on the actives of the Department of Transportation and the findings from the audit of their program over the past year. DEMLR staff recommended to continue delegation of the NCDOT Erosion and Sedimentation Control Program. A discussion ensued. Mr. North made a motion to Continue Delegation of the NCDOT Erosion and Sedimentation Control Program. Mr. Holder made a second. The motion passed.

Updates to the Memorandum of Agreement between Local Governments and the Commission:

Mr. Parrish presented the final draft of the updated Memorandum of Agreement, including edits provided by the Commission Counsel and changes discussed during the review at the previous Commission Meeting. Mr. Holder moved to approve the proposed changes to the Memorandum of Agreement. Mr. North made a second. The motion passed.

INFORMATION ITEMS

Update on Municipal Separate Storm Sewer System (MS4) permit changes in NC:

Mr. Parrish presented a summary of the recent communications DEMLR has been engaged in with the EPA regarding the MS4 permits. Mr. Parrish explained the potential impacts these changes could have on the DEMLR sediment program, existing and new locally delegated programs. A discussion ensued. Ms. Smith requested a follow-up regarding the discussions with EPA and the reasoning behind the changes.

NCDOT Report

Mr. Parrish stated that no trout buffer waivers have been issued by the DEMLR to the DOT this quarter and presented the ICAs and follow-up inspection reports that the DOT had issued this quarter.

Education Program Status Report

Ms. Rebecca Coppa presented her activities related to education and outreach. She gave a reminder of the upcoming NC E&SC Workshop on December 4, 2025, and announced the dates for the 2026 Local Program Workshop on April 14th and 15th, 2026. Ms. Coppa solicited presenters and topic suggestions for this workshop. Ms. Coppa also announced an upcoming Contractor Workshop hosted by the Raleigh Regional Office being planned for January 29, 2026.

Commission Technical Committee Update

Ms. Coppa provided an update from the Committee Chair, Mr. Mark Taylor, regarding the progress made by the Committee over the last quarter.

Land Quality Section Active Sediment Cases and Enforcement

Mr. Parrish presented the number of active enforcement cases and any updates on those cases since the previous quarter meeting.

Sediment Program Status Report

Mr. Parrish presented data to the members on the activities of the regional offices. Data was compiled from the past fiscal year.

Land Quality Section Report

Mr. Toby Vinson presented a summary of the current vacancies within DEMLR and recent position fillings.
