## **NPDES Stormwater Permit Fees**

## Fees are authorized in NCGS 143-215.3D

**IMPORTANT UPDATE:** In accordance with <u>General Statute 143B-279.19</u>, the North Carolina Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) has adjusted <u>certain</u> <u>fees and rates</u> for its programs to support the delivery of services and issuance of environmental permits. This is effective as of July 1, 2025.

NCDOT's statewide stormwater permit is also considered a Major individual NPDES stormwater permit.

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>2</sup> Minor Individual NPDES Stormwater (SW) permits are for small MS4s that do not qualify for a Major individual stormwater permit and industrial facilities that are not eligible for coverage under one of NC's NPDES stormwater general permits.

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>3</sup> The application fee for a new permit is <u>nonrefundable</u> even if the application is denied.

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>4</sup> Annual fee means a fee collected on an annual basis beginning one year after initial permit issuance.

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>5</sup> Major modification means any modification of a permit that is not a minor modification. Major modifications include, but are not limited to: changes to compliance schedules, changes to benchmarks, material and substantial alterations to the permitted facility or on-site activity, etc. The fee for a major modification is <u>nonrefundable</u> even if the application is denied.

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>6</sup> *Minor modification* is defined in 40 CFR 122.63 (e.g., correct typographical errors, increase monitoring frequency, name/ownership change, outfall removal in certain circumstances, etc.)

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>7</sup> No Exposure Exclusion fee is for the first year only. No fee is required after the first year.
