

**PUBLIC NOTICE
VULCAN CONSTRUCTION MATERIALS:
GOLD HILL QUARRY EXPANSION**

PUBLIC NOTICE is hereby given that VULCAN CONSTRUCTION MATERIALS has applied to the North Carolina Division of Water Quality for an Isolated Wetlands Permit pursuant to Environmental Management Commission rules in 15A NCAC 2H .1300. The activity for which this Permit is sought is permanent excavation of 1.59 acres of isolated wetlands to construct the GOLD HILL QUARRY EXPANSION in Cabarrus and Rowan Counties near the town of Gold Hill. Compensatory mitigation for these impacts is proposed to obtain mitigation credits at a 2:1 ratio through payment to the NC Ecosystem Enhancement Program. Stormwater from this site is to be treated through on-site facilities.

The public is invited to comment in writing to the Division of Water Quality on the above-mentioned application. Comments shall be sent to the N.C. Comments must be received by DWQ by July 19, 2005.
