



In partnership with DEACS, the Waste Reduction Partners team is proud to extend the Division technical assistance services through on-site, one-on-one facility assessments and special projects. For the 2018-19 fiscal year, WRP will be focused on supporting the following services.

### **Energy Efficiency Assessments**

Waste Reduction Partners can help your organization identify energy efficiency opportunities and better understand and manage utility costs through an energy efficiency survey. WRP engineers provide clients with written reports highlighting project opportunities, energy-use benchmarks, cost/benefit analysis, financing strategies, and technical resources.





### Water-Use Efficiency

WRP professionals offer on-site assessments to identify water efficiency strategies for large businesses and institutions. The team produces a site report with water balances, efficiency strategies, reuse options and preliminary cost/benefit analysis. A special focus this year will be with organizations located within the Neuse and Haw River watersheds.

### Zero Waste to Landfill Reduction

The WRP team will visit your facility, learn your objectives, and research waste reduction strategies customized for you. The team provides assistance in reducing the amount of material sent to landfills, reusing by-products in-house, developing new or improved recycling program- all while seeking the most cost-effective solutions.





### Agricultural Plastics Recycling

The NC Ag Plastics Recycling project was created to assist growers with recycling options for a variety of farm and nursery-generated waste plastics including plastic pots, trays, flats and hoop house films. Two ag plastic collection sites have been created at the Piedmont-Triad and Raleigh State Farmers Markets. The team is working on improving mulch film and drip-tape retrieval techniques for emerging recycling markets.
