



## **OUR FACILITY**

- Shared 550-acre campus with the National Institute of Environmental Health Sciences (NIEHS)
- 1.2 million square feet of office, laboratory, computer and conference spaces
- The largest facility ever built by EPA (not leased from GSA)
- Host to 15 different EPA
   offices and are the largest
   laboratory facility for EPA
- 100+ acre site; 85-acres of natural area


More energy than office spaces




More water than office spaces



Pounds of plastic waste each year



### **EPA-RTP EMS: GREENING OUR LABS AT EPA-RTP**

Encouraging researchers to purchase less toxic chemicals and use our Chemical Adoption Program for excess.

Annual inventory to track all refrigerant equipment on campus through the entire lifecycle.

Finding a way to responsibly excess laboratory equipment.

Recycling lab glass, and other clean lab materials by finding a recycler willing to take it. Initiating our My Green Labs program in FY21 and starting with our two pilot labs in FY22.
