Examples of Fats, Oils and Grease that Should Not Go Down the Drain

FATS:

Meat Trimmings Uncooked Poultry Skin Cheeses Ice Cream Peanut Butter

Butter

Place fats directly in the trash can or another container to put in the trash can for proper disposal.

OIL:

Salad Dressing Cooking Oil Vegetable Oil Canola Oil Olive Oil

Corn Oil



Pour used oil into a jar or can with a lid before placing in the trash can. Hot water and soap do not eliminate oil; it will eventually reform in pipes.

GREASE:

Cooked/Melted Fat from Meat

Bacon/Sausage

Skin from Boiled Poultry

Gravy

Mayonnaise

Salad Dressing

Pour liquid grease into a grease can or other container with a lid and place in trash can once it has cooled. Running hot water over greasy cookware in the sink only pushes it into the pipes where it hardens.
