

Examples of Fats, Oils and Grease that Should Not Go Down the Drain

FATS:

Meat Trimmings
Uncooked Poultry Skin
Cheeses
Ice Cream
Peanut Butter
Butter

****Place fats directly in the trash can or another container to put in the trash can for proper disposal.****

OIL:

Salad Dressing
Cooking Oil
Vegetable Oil
Canola Oil
Olive Oil
Corn Oil



****Pour used oil into a jar or can with a lid before placing in the trash can. Hot water and soap do not eliminate oil; it will eventually reform in pipes.****

GREASE:

Cooked/Melted Fat from Meat
Bacon/Sausage
Skin from Boiled Poultry
Gravy
Mayonnaise
Salad Dressing

****Pour liquid grease into a grease can or other container with a lid and place in trash can once it has cooled. Running hot water over greasy cookware in the sink only pushes it into the pipes where it hardens.****
