Water Supply Watershed Protection (WSWSP) Program Permits

What Activities Require This Permit? Development activities that can impact water bodies within the water supply watersheds.

What Is the Purpose of This Permit? To establish minimum statewide water supply watershed protection requirements applicable to each classification to protect surface water supplies by (1) controlling development density, (2) providing for performance based alternatives to development density control based on sound engineering principles or combination of (1) and (2).

Who Issues This Permit?

This program is implemented at the local level, so the county or municipality implementing the program issues permits.
