Dear Ms. Compton:

The North Carolina Department of Environmental Quality (NCDEQ) has reviewed the e-mail titled "Chemours – Release of HFPO Dimer Acid from Remediation Activity", dated April 20, 2018, for the Chemours Facility, Fayetteville, North Carolina. Based upon the review of the e-mail the NCDEQ has determined that Chemours must report all spills or releases of the facility under its current RCRA permit. Part I.D.14 of the Permit states: "The Permittee shall report to the Department any noncompliance which may endanger health or the environment." Furthermore, Part I D.15. Standard Conditions of the Permit states: "The Permittee shall report all other instances of noncompliance not otherwise required to be reported at the time monitoring reports are submitted. The reports shall contain the information listed in Condition I.D.14."

Be advised that failure to report such releases or spills may constitute a violation of the current RCRA permit.
