#### **Division of Marine Fisheries – Marine Patrol**

From January through December 31, 2023, Marine Patrol officers issued 2 citations and 2 warnings for littering violations. Marine Patrol officers attributed 393 hours to this effort. In 2022, Marine Patrol officers issued 3 citations and 1 warning for a total of 4 littering cases expending 289 hours.

The North Carolina Marine Patrol concentrated its litter enforcement on coastal waters this year. The number of littering violations remained the same as the previous year.
