SCFLs Available in 2021–2022 License Year

Determination of Available SCFLs for 2020-2021 License Year	
Total original SCFLs available (Cap)	8,896
SCFLs issued and renewed in 2020–2021	<u> </u>
SCFLs available in the pool for 2021–2022	3,203
2020–2021 approved SCFLs not yet issued*	<u> </u>
SCFLs available for 2021–2022 license year	3,198

*Individuals approved in the spring (March 2021) have until June 30 of the following license year (2022) to purchase their SCFL




Fiscal Year 2021 Considerations

- 54 SCFL applications received
 - \circ 45 approved
 - \circ 9 denials
- 9.8% increase in applications from FY2020
 - \circ 5 pending applications
