

North Carolina Department of Environmental Quality **Division of Marine Fisheries** BLANKET FOR-HIRE CAPTAIN'S COASTAL RECREATIONAL FISHING LICENSE (CRFL) **APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS** (REV 2022-03)

Attached is an application for a Blanket For-Hire Captain's Coastal Recreational Fishing License. This license allows individuals licensed by the United States Coast Guard to carry passengers on any vessel licensed in NC as a for-hire vessel. Only individuals holding a USCG license to carry passengers are eligible to apply. This license covers the recreational fishing license requirements for all anglers aboard the vessel when fishing in coastal fishing waters that are not joint or inland fishing waters. See NC General Statute 113-174.3 for regulations governing for-hire licensing. Individuals applying for a license for another under the authority of Power of Attorney must submit a **PHOTOCOPY** of the Power of Attorney and current picture identification.

Provide a **PHOTOCOPY** of one of the following current picture identifications:

- Driver's License; or •
 - State Identification (issued by DMV); or
- Passport; or Resident Alien Card (green card)
- Military Identification; or •

A Blanket For-Hire Captain's CRFL Application:

- Sign the Application. •
- Complete the NC DMF License Certification Statement Form. It must be notarized if applying for a new license. •
- A PHOTOCOPY of valid vessel state registration or U.S. Coast Guard Vessel documentation. •
- A PHOTOCOPY of all valid United States Coast Guard Operators certifications (Masters, OUPV, etc.) suitable for • the passenger rating you are applying for.

- See Commercial License and Permit Fee Sheet. If you need assistance, please contact any NC DMF License • Office or call (252) 726-7021 or (800) 682-2632. Replacement Fee: There is a \$5.00 fee for replacing current/valid license.
- Method of payment: Personal check, money order or Cashier check. Make payable to North Carolina Division of • Marine Fisheries. There will be a \$25.00 service charge for returned checks.

You are required to notify the Division of Marine Fisheries of any address or residency changes within 30 days. Incomplete applications submitted without required documentation will be deemed incomplete and returned to you unprocessed.
