# **PROCLAMATION**

### **RE: SHELLFISH POLLUTED AREA**

Kathy B. Rawls, Director, Division of Marine Fisheries, upon the recommendation of Betsey Tilson, M.D., M.P.H., State Health Director, Department of Health and Human Services, hereby announces that the following changes in shellfish harvesting areas will take effect at sunrise, Sunday, December 17, 2023.

All those waters in Pender, Onslow, and Carteret Counties will return to the status in existence immediately prior to the December 11, 2023 temporary closures, except the following which remains closed:

# **ONSLOW / CARTERET COUNTIES**

<u>All those waters</u> bordered on the north by a line beginning at a point 34° 31.1227′ N - 77° 22.3142′ W on the mainland, running southerly near Beacon "15" to a point 34° 31.0527′ N - 77° 22.2654′ W on North Topsail Beach, near Galleon Bay; and bordered on the south by a line beginning at a point 34° 28.2180′ N - 77° 30.5521′ W on the mainland near Morris Landing, running southeasterly near Beacon "49" to a point on Topsail Island at 34° 27.273′ N -77° 29.937′ W, to include a portion of Stump Sound and Alligator Bay.

<u>All those waters from the Intracoastal Waterway to the mainland</u> between the Emerald Isle High Rise Bridge and IWW Beacon "59" (34° 37.3978'N - 77° 12.6533' W), to include the Intracoastal Waterway, Bear Creek, Queens Creek, and White Oak River.

<u>North River - All those waters</u> upstream of a straight line beginning at a point 34° 44.4581′N - 76° 37.3826′ W on the shore south of Cow Pen Creek; running easterly near the old Fl. "Danger" Beacon to a point 34° 44.4929′ N - 76° 35.3320′ W on the northwest shore of Goose Bay, to include all of Ward Creek.

<u>Jarrett Bay - All those waters in Jarrett Bay</u> upstream of a line beginning at a point 34° 45.9213' N - 76° 29.2047' W on the east shore of Spit Bay; thence in a straight line to a point 34° 45.7944' N - 76° 29.3623' W at the northern tip of Davis Island; thence in a straight line to a point 34° 45.5281' N - 76° 30.1032' W at the "Chimney" near Jump Run Creek.

<u>Oyster Creek - All those waters in Oyster Creek</u> upstream of a straight line across the mouth, beginning at a point 34° 48.8185' N - 76° 26.9761' W on the west shore; running northeasterly to a point 34° 48.9768' N - 76° 26.6340' W on the east shore.

<u>Nelson Bay - All those waters in Nelson Bay</u> upstream of a line from Drum Point to the northern tip of Fulchers Creek.

## The following also remains closed:

# **BRUNSWICK COUNTY**

<u>All those waters</u> bordered on the east by a line beginning at a point 33° 54.2904′ N - 78° 23.6416′ W on the mainland near the Bricklanding Road Public Boat Ramp and IWW Beacon "84"; running southerly to a point 33° 54.1932′ N - 78° 23.6426′ W on Ocean Isle Beach near Ferry Landing Park; and bordered on the west by the permanent closure line near IWW Marker "89" in Ocean Isle.

### **GENERAL INFORMATION:**

- A. This proclamation is issued under the authority of N.C.G.S. 113-170.4; 113-170.5; 113-182; 113-221.1; 143B-289.52 and N.C. Marine Fisheries Commission Rules 15A NCAC 03H .0103 and 03K .0101.
- B. It is unlawful to violate the provisions of any proclamation issued by the N.C. Fisheries Director under their delegated authority pursuant to N.C. Marine Fisheries Commission Rule 15A NCAC 03H .0103.
- C. In accordance with N.C. General Statute 113-221.1(c) all persons who may be affected by proclamations issued by the Fisheries Director are under a duty to keep themselves informed of current proclamations.
- D. This proclamation returns the following areas to normal closure boundaries: A portion of Stump Sound, Chadwick Bay, Bogue Sound, Goose Creek, Deer Creek, Hunting Island Bay, Newport River, and Core Creek.
- E. These openings are due to satisfactory bacteriological sampling results.
