PROCLAMATION

RE: SHELLFISH POLLUTED AREA

Kathy B. Rawls, Director, Division of Marine Fisheries, upon the recommendation of Betsey Tilson, M.D., M.P.H., State Health Director, Department of Health and Human Services, hereby announces that the following changes in shellfish harvesting areas will take effect at sunrise, Wednesday, June 28, 2023.

All those waters in Onslow and Carteret Counties will return to the status in existence immediately prior to the June 21 and June 27, 2023 temporary closures, **except the following which remain closed:**

ONSLOW COUNTY

<u>All those waters</u> bordered on the north by the North Topsail High Rise Bridge; and bordered on the south by a line beginning at a point 34° 21.4312′N - 77° 40.8731′ W on the mainland near Forest Sound Marina; running southerly near IWW Markers "98A" and "99A" and following the western shore of Black Mud Channel to the northern tip of Hutaff Island near New Topsail Inlet, to include all of Black Mud Channel, a portion of Topsail Sound, Old Topsail Creek, Virginia Creek, Beckys Creek, and Stump Sound.

The following also remains closed:

BRUNSWICK / NEW HANOVER / PENDER COUNTIES

<u>All those waters</u> bordered on the east by a line beginning at a point 33° 54.2904′ N - 78° 23.6416′ W on the mainland near the Bricklanding Road Public Boat Ramp and IWW Beacon "84"; running southerly to a point 33° 54.1932′ N - 78° 23.6426′ W on Ocean Isle Beach near Ferry Landing Park; and bordered on the west by the South Carolina State Line, to include Tubbs Inlet.

<u>Lockwoods Folly River - All those waters</u> north of a line beginning at a point 33° 55.5678′ N - 78° 13.8043′ W on the south shore of Spring Creek near the mouth; running easterly to a point 33° 55.4621′N - 78° 13.1714′ W near the northern tip of Sheep Island; thence running southeasterly to a point 33° 55.2284′N - 78° 12.7791′ W near the northwest point of Horse Island, to include a portion of the Intracoastal Waterway north of Horse and Sheep Islands.

<u>All those waters</u> in Middle Sound bordered on the north by the Figure Eight Island Bridge and bordered on the south by the Wrightsville Beach Bridge, to include Pages Creek.

All those waters from the Intracoastal Waterway to the mainland between IWW Marker "98A" (34° 21.3210'N - 77° 40.8610' W) near Forest Sound Marina and the Figure Eight Island Bridge, to include the Intracoastal Waterway.

<u>All those waters</u> bordered on the north by the North Topsail High Rise Bridge; and bordered on the south by a line beginning at a point 34° 21.4312′N - 77° 40.8731′ W on the mainland near Forest Sound Marina; running southerly near IWW Markers "98A" and "99A" and following the western shore of Black Mud Channel to the northern tip of Hutaff Island near New Topsail Inlet, to include all of Black Mud Channel, a portion of Topsail Sound, Old Topsail Creek, Virginia Creek, Beckys Creek, and Stump Sound.

GENERAL INFORMATION:

- A. This proclamation is issued under the authority of N.C.G.S. 113-170.4; 113-170.5; 113-182; 113-221.1; 143B-289.52 and N.C. Marine Fisheries Commission Rules 15A NCAC 03H .0103 and 03K .0101.
- B. It is unlawful to violate the provisions of any proclamation issued by the N.C. Fisheries Director under their delegated authority pursuant to N.C. Marine Fisheries Commission Rule 15A NCAC 03H .0103.
- C. In accordance with N.C. General Statute 113-221.1(c) all persons who may be affected by proclamations issued by the Fisheries Director are under a duty to keep themselves informed of current proclamations.
- D. This proclamation returns the following areas to normal closure boundaries: Queens Creek, White Oak River, Newport River, Core Creek, North River, and Ward Creek.
- E. These openings are due to satisfactory bacteriological sampling results.
