# Public Hearing: Stericycle, Inc.

### AIR QUALITY PERMIT OVERVIEW

Stericycle, Inc. currently operates two incinerators for the disposal of hospital, medical and infectious waste at its facility in Haw River. It applied to the N.C. Division of Air Quality (DAQ) to renew its Title V air quality permit without any modifications.

The facility's control equipment limits emissions of nitrogen oxides, sulfur dioxide, particulate matter and acid gases. In December 2022, Stericycle and DAQ entered into a consent order to resolve numerous violations related to Stericycle bypassing its pollution controls. The consent order required Stericycle to make upgrades to its facility to reduce future bypasses.

#### **Facility Location**

Stericycle is at 1168 Porter Ave., Haw River, near the Jimmie Kerr Road exit from Interstate 40, between Burlington and Mebane (Figure 1). It is close to Alamance Community College.
