Project Description: Rehabilitation of aeration basins to include concrete repairs and replacement of aeration assembly with disc aerators; replacement of bar screen, chemical feed pumps, RAS/WAS pumps, sludge holding tank aerators and mixers, belt filter press, polymer system, and solids handling pumps; conversion of gas to liquid chlorination/dichlorination system; improvements to the dewatering building, chemical storage building, and operations building; installation of SCADA and a backup generator.

The above-named applicant will receive funding assistance from the State Revolving Fund. The North Carolina Division of Water Infrastructure (Division) has conducted a review of the project in accordance with the NCGS §159G-38. The Division has determined that this project is below the minor construction activities threshold outlined in the 15A NCAC 01C .0408; therefore, the project is exempt from inter-agency review, and the preparation of additional environmental documents is not required.
