SCFLs Available in 2025–2026 License Year

Determination of Available SCFLs for 2025-2026 License Year	
Total original SCFLs available (Cap)	8,896
SCFLs issued and renewed in 2024–2025	- 5,198
2024–2025 approved SCFLs not yet issued*	<u> </u>
SCFLs available for 2025–2026 license year	3,693




^{*}Individuals approved in the spring (April 2025) have until June 30 of the following license year (2026) to purchase their SCFL

Considerations from 2024-2025 License Year

- 40 SCFL applications received
 - 39 approved
 - o 1 denials
- 8% increase in total applications from previous year
