

- 4-18-11 Notice to proceed to Hydrologics
- 6-30-11 DWR update the historical withdrawal/Discharge data.
- 11-1-11 Draft model complete & users provide to DWR updated 2060 projections.
- 1-18-12 Model update completed.
- 8-1-12 Draft Cape Fear Water Supply Plan completed.
- 9-1-12 Applicants submit final Jordan applications.
- 1-2013 Final Water Supply Plan and DWR's Allocation recommendations presented to the EMC.
- 11-2013 EMC makes final allocation determination, if there are no IBTs.








#### Cape Fear and Neuse River Basin Schematic














