Project Description: The proposed project will make the following improvements to the Town's Dutchman Creek Wastewater Treatment Plant: rehabilitation of the wastewater treatment plant to include replacement of influent screen; installation of new clarifier splitter box; demolition of three clarifiers and replace with two 60-foot diameter secondary clarifiers with two scum pumps; replacement of four RAS pumps and two WAS pumps; installation of new sludge thickening building with new gravity belt thickener and two thickened sludge pumps, and polymer feed system; new 254,000 gallon aerobic digester with course bubble diffusers; two new digester blowers; rehabilitation of the existing digester with new course bubble diffusers; and associated electrical and instrumentation appurtenances.

The above-named applicant will receive funding assistance from the State Revolving Fund. The North Carolina Division of Water Infrastructure (Division) has conducted a review of the project in accordance with the NCGS §159G-38. The Division has determined that this project is below the minor construction activities threshold outlined in 15A NCAC 01C .0408; therefore, the project is exempt from inter-agency review, and the preparation of additional environmental documents is not required.
