The WQRO Section has regulatory authority to ensure both groundwater and surface water quality are protected from adverse impacts resulting from various types of wastewater collection and disposal practices through comprehensive permitting, inspection, and enforcement activities. Other programmatic areas that are essential to maintaining water quality are regulating groundwater well development, wetland protection and restoration, watershed protection, providing technical assistance to permit holders, ambient water quality monitoring, participation in scientific studies and investigating all types of reported citizen concerns such as polluted groundwater and fish kills.
