

FACT SHEET – SJAFB DRAFT RENEWAL PERMIT [NC7570024474]

A Draft Renewal Permit has been prepared for the Seymour Johnson Air Force Base (SJAFB) facility which has a RCRA Hazardous and Solid Waste Amendments (HSWA) Permit issued by the State of North Carolina under the Federal Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA). North Carolina has been authorized by the USEPA to administer RCRA including HSWA of 1984.

This permit requires the facility to conduct soil and groundwater investigation and remediation activities related to past releases of wastes or waste constituents from Solid Waste Management Units (SWMUs) and Areas of Concern (AOCs) at the base. Remedies for corrective action at the SWMUs and AOCs have been selected and are completed or in operation at all SWMUs and AOCs. Remedies include Long Term Groundwater Monitoring in addition to various active remedies.

The North Carolina Hazardous Waste Management Rules require that the public be given a forty-five (45) day period to comment on the draft modified permit. This forty-five (45) day period is August 15 through September 29, 2026. The draft modified permit can be found online at the following site:
