SAMPLE **CAN BE CUSTOMIZED**

YARD WASTE: Leaves, plant materials, grass clippings, brush and limbs. **BAG IT. BIN IT. BUNDLE IT.**

DO THIS:

Use paper bags, boxes or trash cans no larger than 32 gallons sealed shut or with a lid.

Use twine or string to tie limbs in bundles no wider than 14 inches and no longer than 4 feet.

Make sure yard waste weighs 30 pounds or less when you bag it, bin it or bundle it.

Place your yard debris in the right-of-way on your own property — not on the street.

NOT THIS:

Do not use plastic bags!

Do not put stumps or items wider than 6 inches or heavier than 30 pounds with your yard waste.

Do not place yard waste on the curbside earlier than 72 hours prior to collection day as it is prohibited by town ordinance.

TIPS:



Meet yard waste requirements by splitting or sawing larger debris.

Purchase yard waste bags locally or at the town hall.

Arrange to take scrap lumber and larger items to an approved county disposal site.
