NC Stream Watch

Tips for taking photos:

- 1. Anyone can share an image of their stream!
- 2. Include as much of the stream and surrounding land use as possible.
- 3. Take a picture facing up stream if possible.
- 4. Be sure to include the actual water in the stream.
- 5. Avoid having humans in the picture, especially faces.
- 6. Turn your phone sideways to offer a wide view of the stream, including both stream banks.
- 7. Always be aware of your surroundings!
- 8. It is always a good idea to carry a first-aid kit when in the field.
- 9. If you plan to take multiple pictures over time, try to include a marker, like a unique tree, in the image.

Things to avoid:

- Pictures of a single object in or around a stream. (Zoom out!)
- Image not including stream/water.
- Images from private property or featuring private property without land owner consent. (Ask permission.)
