1	The Comment fields located on the Main Report screen, Effluent Page, Influent Page, Upstream Page and Downstream Page only allow 1024 characters. The allowable comment size needs to be increased and all comments need to be included in the PDF.	All comment fields have been increased to the maximum allowed size of 4000 characters on the Main Report screen, Effluent Page, Influent Page, Upstream Page and Downstream Page. Additionally, all comment sections will be included in the generated PDF so users will effectively have commenting capability up to 20,000 characters in a report. Each Comment section will be provided on a separate page at the end of the PDF.
2	The new NPDES WW General Permit, NCG590000, entitled "Water Treatment Plant Dischargers - Backwash Wastewater from Green Sand & Conventional Systems" needs to be added as an allowable permit type for submitting DMRs electronically in the eDMR system.	The new NPDES WW General Permit, NCG590000, has been added to eDMR as an allowable permit type for reporting DMRs electronically. These permits can now be registered for eDMR and submit DMR data electronically.
3	eDMR does not calculate the "Monthly Avg % Removal (85%)". The last line on in TOTALS area of the daily values entry screen and the PDF that states "Monthly Avg % Removal (85%):" needs to be removed.	The last line that states "Monthly Avg % Removal (85%):" in the TOTALS area of the daily values entry screen and the PDF has been removed. Facilities needing to report % Removal for BOD and TSS will do so by using the appropriate parameter codes provided.
4	The NCDENR Logo needs to be replaced with the new NC Logo on the eDMR webpage.	The NCDENR log on the eDMR page headers has been changed to the new NC Logo.
5	The Facility address on the Certify and Submit screen has a format issue and displays "null" as part of the Facility address.	On the Certify and Submit screen, the format issue for the facility address has been corrected and no longer displays "null" in the street address.

6	After clicking the Submit action, the Submit screen appears with the Certification Statement check box. In the upper right, there is a PDF Report icon. When the PDF Report icon is clicked on the Submit Screen, an error occurs.	The PDF Report icon in the upper right of the Submit screen has been corrected and no longer causes an error when clicked. The PDF Report can now be generated from the Submit screen.
7	The PDF cannot be generated without the Compliance Status. Upon clicking the PDF icon when no Compliance Status is selected, an error will occur. The PDF should be allowed to be generated without a Compliance Status as many users will not select the Compliance Status until the data has been fully reviewed.	The PDF can now be generated without the Compliance Status being selected. This will allow users to review the report in PDF format before making the Compliance Status selection in the report.
8	An Average value is being displayed for pH in the TOTALS area of the daily values entry screen and at the bottom of the PDF. pH values cannot be averaged so the Average calculation should be prevented for the pH parameter.	The Average values are no longer displayed for the "pH" parameter (PCS Code 00400) in the TOTALS area of the daily values entry screen or in the PDF.
9	When a selection is made for "No Reporting Reason" in the Log Parameters section, the system will not allow Operator visitation to be entered. This information should be allowed to be entered when a "No Reporting Reason" is selected.	Operator visitation information can now be entered when a "No Reporting Reason" is selected in the Log Parameters section of the data entry screens.
