Dear Mr. Najera,

Your letter requesting an air permit applicability determination was received by this office on June 27, 2013. As stated in your letter, Enviva requests to install a hammermill vent following the existing dried wood handling system (ID No. IES-DWHS). The dried wood handling system will vent directly to the existing high pressure blower conveyor to supplement inlet ambient air. The dried wood day silo (ID No. ES-DWDS) will not change as a result of this closed loop vent and no increase in emissions is expected.

According to your letter, the dried wood handling system includes a hammermill, enclosed conveyor system, and cyclone. The system is currently totally enclosed with the vent from the cyclone feeding back into the hammermill. The new vent will be located after the cyclone and will draw a portion of the system air. The vent will go through an enclosed filter to the dry material transfer blower. A check valve will be installed to close the vent when the silo is not being filled.

DAQ has determined that an air permit revision is not necessary for installation of the hammermill vent as you describe.

Dear Kevin:

Enviva Pellets Ahoskie, LLC (Ahoskie), requests a permit determination on the proposal to install a hammermill vent after the insignificant dried wood handling system, IES-DWHS that will vent directly to the existing high pressure blower conveyor to supplement inlet ambient air as shown on Appendix A. The emission source, the Dried Wood Day Silo, will not change as a result of this closed loop vent and no increase in emissions are expected.

Currently, the bin vent filter emissions are based on a design flow rate through a filter of 2,186 cubic feet per minute. As shown in the appendix, a dry material transfer blower will use the dry wood hammermill vent air along with ambient air to make up the air that is required for blowing wood fiber into the dried wood day silo (ES-DWDS).

The Dried Wood Handling System (IES-DWHS) is included on the insignificant source list attached to Enviva's permit. The system contains a hammermill, enclosed conveyor system and a cyclone. The system is currently totally enclosed with the vent from the cyclone feeding back into the hammermill. The new vent will be located after the cyclone and will draw a portion of the system air. The vent will go through an enclosed filter to the dry material transfer blower. A check valve will be installed to close the vent when the silo is not being filled (IES-DWHS would then operate as it does now). The following regulations were triggered by the original addition of the Dried Wood Day Silo (ES-DWDS):

- 15A NCAC 2D .0515, Particulates from Miscellaneous Industrial Processes and
- 15A NCAC 2D .0521, Control of Visible Emissions.

No changes in compliance with the regulations will result from adding the new vent to the dry material transfer blower and ES-DWDS will remain in compliance with the applicable particulate matter and visible emissions standards.







Current Layout:




