Enviva Pellets Hamlet, LLC has applied to the North Carolina Department of Environment and Natural Resources, Division of Air Quality (DAQ) for approval of a project for installing a new wood pellets manufacturing facility. The facility will be located at

The project is subject to review and processing under the North Carolina Administrative Code, Title 15A, Environment Management Subchapter 2D Section .0530 "Prevention of Significant Deterioration" and Subchapter 2Q Section .0300 "Construction and Operation

The permit application has been reviewed by the DAQ, Air Permitting Section, Raleigh, North Carolina, to determine compliance with the requirements of the North Carolina Environmental Management Commission's air pollution regulations.
