After review of the leak detection evaluations, the UST Section has determined that the above equipment meets the leak detection requirements listed in federal regulation 40 CFR 280.45(a) (as incorporated by 15A NCAC 2N .0506) and as described in 40 CFR 280.40(a)(3) (as incorporated by 15A NCAC 2N .0501) as long as the components used in the remanufacturing process have not changed from the components used in the original leak detection evaluations your company had completed on March 13, 2015 and the sensors are used with non-remanufactured Automatic Tank Gauge consoles listed in the original March 13, 2015 evaluation.
