Summary of Fall 2023 Application Round

Division of Water Infrastructure Staff Report

Background

The Fall 2023 application round for the following funds closed on October 2, 2023:

- American Rescue Plan Act Funds study grants
- Clean Water State Revolving Fund (CWSRF)
- Drinking Water State Revolving Fund (DWSRF)
- Bipartisan Infrastructure Law (BIL) Emerging Contaminants (EC) funding for the CWSRF and DWSRF
- State Reserve Program (SRP)
- Community Development Block Grant – Infrastructure (CDBG-I)
- Local Assistance for Stormwater Infrastructure Investments (LASII)

At its February 2024 meeting, the State Water Infrastructure Authority will have a total of approximately \$238 million in loans and grants to apply to approximately \$1.95 billion in requests.. The application data does not include applications for lead service line funds that may be received and considered for funding in February 2024. Table 1 provides more detail on the applications received and funds available for different project application types.
