

Applications selected for funding by the State Water Infrastructure Authority on July 15, 2026

On July 15, 2026, North Carolina's State Water Infrastructure Authority (SWIA) approved funding assistance (loans and/or grants) for the following applications. Applicants will be notified of their funding awards by the NC Department of Environmental Quality's Division of Water Infrastructure with a Letter of Intent to Fund.

Construction project types include Drinking Water, Wastewater, Drinking Water and Wastewater (Community Development Block Grant-Infrastructure), Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act (IIJA) Drinking Water Emerging Contaminants, IIJA Wastewater Emerging Contaminants, and IIJA Lead Service Line Replacements.

Planning project types include IIJA Drinking Water Emerging Contaminants Evaluation/Assessment Studies and IIJA Lead Service Line Inventories.
