





### Jordan Rule Readoption Schedule



- We are currently in Round 3 TAGs this is the last Agriculture TAG.
- Next steps: Complete final revisions, fiscal analysis, and present to EMC in Jan or March 2026. If approved by EMC, there will be a 90-day public comment period, and it is possible there will be rule revisions according to these comments. We plan to bring this riparian buffer rule to EMC with the Jordan Rules.

### **Previous TAGs**

**AG TAG #1**: Reviewed current state of Jordan agriculture, current implementation, and proposed initial reporting and cattle collective compliance changes.

**Biosolids TAG:** Reviewed available biosolids land application permit data collection. Agreed that need better data collection and tracking to support future regulations.

**AG TAG#2:** Some consensus that cattle exclusion from surface waters would reduce nutrient loading in Jordan watershed. Agreed to review cattle exclusion collective compliance.

**-Meetings:** Consensus to remove current agriculture rule requiring NLEW reporting and replace with an agreement for agriculture reporting.

AG TAG#3: Today – Draft rule proposal and ag reporting agreement
