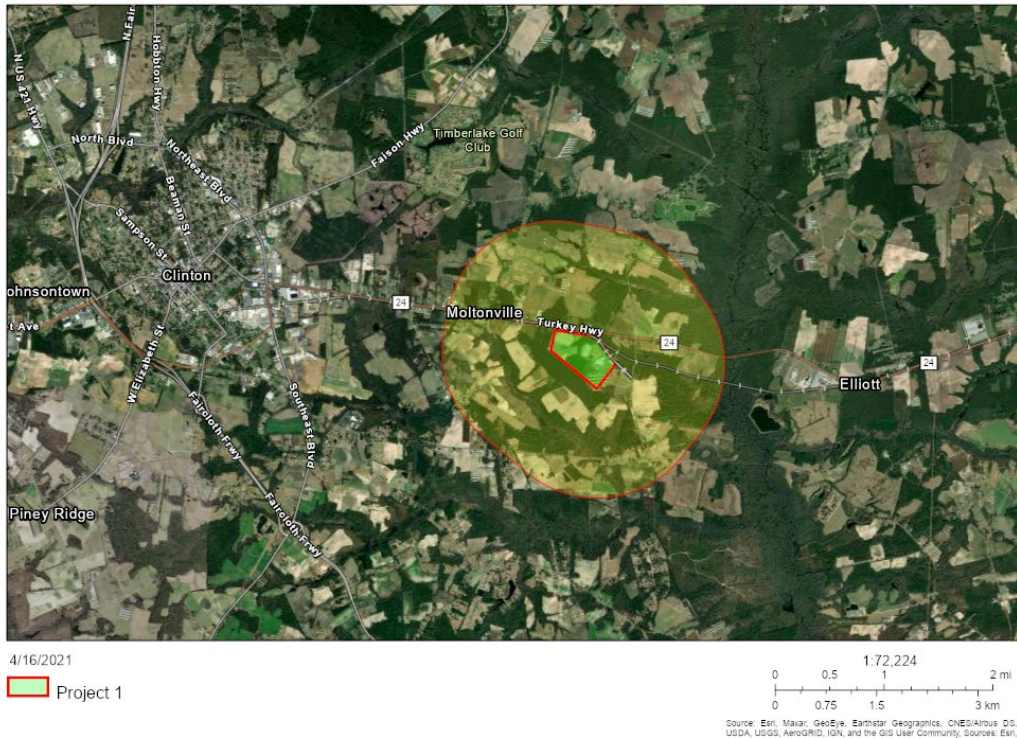


Prestage AgEnergy - Moltonville

Background: Prestage AgEnergy – Moltonville, located at 311 Prestage Mill Lane near Clinton, is a biomass-to-energy facility that is currently permitted as part of the Prestage Farms – Moltonville facility, an animal feed mill. The facility has submitted an application to operate the existing biomass-to-energy equipment under a separate permit from Prestage Farms. The facility has added control equipment that has decreased potential particulate matter emissions. Changes to boiler operation limits will increase the potential to emit of nitrogen oxides (NOx) and carbon monoxide (CO) and require a Title V air permit. Facilities are subject to Title V permitting requirements if they have the potential to emit 100 tons or more per year of criteria pollutants such as nitrogen oxides, sulfur dioxide, volatile organic compounds, or particulate matter of 10 microns or smaller.
