PUBLIC NOTICE**

PURPOSE:

The North Carolina Department of Environmental Quality, Division of Air Quality (DAQ), hereby gives notice regarding its Pre-hearing Draft of Clean Air Act Section 110(l) Noninterference Demonstration for Revisions to Rule 15A NCAC 02Q .0207, Annual Emissions Reporting. The proposed revisions will remove the administrative burden associated with preparing and submitting emissions statements to the DAQ on the owners or operators of non-Title V facilities with actual emissions of nitrogen oxides or volatile organic compounds ranging from 25 up to 100 tons per year that are located in areas classified as maintenance for the former 1979 1-hour and 1997 8-hour ozone National Ambient Air Quality Standards (NAAQS). Annual emissions reporting requirements for sources located in 2008 ozone NAAQS maintenance areas will be retained. The proposed revisions will not change any air emissions control requirements for the facilities. The existing emissions reporting provisions would remain in place that are applicable during permit modifications and renewals. Additional emissions source verifications would be conducted through compliance inspections. The DAQ demonstrates that this proposed change will have no impact on the emissions and air quality in the areas that are maintenance for the former 1979 1-hour and 1997 8-hour ozone NAAQS. Persons wishing to submit comments or request a public hearing are invited to do so.

Any person wishing to comment may submit a written statement for inclusion in the record of proceedings regarding the Pre-hearing Draft of Clean Air Act Section 110(l) Noninterference Demonstration for Revisions to Rule 15A NCAC 02Q .0207, Annual Emissions Reporting. Written comments should be received by no later than November 20, 2017.


