Dear Mr. Palmer:

I am pleased to submit the Redesignation Demonstration and Maintenance Plan for the Rocky Mount, North Carolina 8-hour Ozone Nonattainment Area. Enclosed is the complete package containing the redesignation demonstration and maintenance plan, the supporting documentation as to how the emission estimates were developed, and the complete hearing record including comments and responses. The State's public hearings took place on March 20, 2006, in Rocky Mount, North Carolina.

The submittal includes three major items. The first is an analysis of the ambient air quality data demonstrating attainment with the 8-hour ozone National Ambient Air Quality Standard. The second is an emissions inventory comparison showing that the 8-hour ozone standard can be maintained for 10 years beyond the approval the plan. The third is the contingency measures to be implemented in the event of an air quality violation or other indications of an impending violation.

I respectfully request that you commence the federal approval process for the Rocky Mount, North Carolina 8-hour ozone nonattainment area redesignation demonstration and maintenance plan. Since very few comments were received on this package, I request that you consider approving this as a direct final action.
