Explanation: North Carolina General Statute 150B-21.3A requires state agencies to readopt existing rules every ten years. To fulfill this statutory obligation, the North Carolina Division of Air Quality divided several air quality rules into six groups. The sixth group of rules proposed for readoption by the State of North Carolina is termed "Group 6".

Recommendation: The Director recommends that the Air Quality Committee approve the proposed readoption of Group 6 air quality rules in 15A NCAC 02D .0403, .0500, .0900, .1400, .1700, and .2615, and the repeal of 15A NCAC 02D .0615 for presentation to the Environmental Management Commission to proceed to public hearing.
