Initial Temporary Operator Requirements:

- Application & non-refundable \$237 processing fee, payable to: WPCSOCC.
- Letter from system owner that includes:
 1. the explanation of need
 2. efforts made to employ an appropriate ORC/Backup ORC,
 3. a statement designating the operator as either ORC or Backup ORC, and
 4. actions that will be taken by system owner and operator to obtain permanent certification

Renewal of Temporary Operator Requirements:

- Applications must be submitted by the owner of the system 60 calendar days prior to the expiration date of the original temporary certificate.
- Application & non-refundable \$356 processing fee, payable to: WPCSOCC.
- Letter from system owner that includes:

1. the need for renewal of the temporary certificate,
 2. the reasons the temporary operator has not obtained permanent certification during the initial period,
 3. the efforts that have been made by the owner to employ a properly certified operator during the initial period,
 4. the actions that will be taken by the applicant to obtain permanent certification during the effective period of the renewed temporary certificate;
 5. the actions that will be taken by the owner if the applicant does not obtain permanent certification during the effective period of the renewed temporary certificate.
- The renewal request shall be denied if the applicant has failed: (1) to seek permanent certification by examination during the original effective period of the temporary certificate; or (2) to obtain permanent certification after four examination attempts during the original effective period of the temporary certificate.
 - A temporary certificate may be renewed only once for the same operator.
